All Saints Day

Sermon: Loving God, Neighbor, and Self

Scripture – Deuteronomy 6:1-9 and Mark 12:28-34

This week we look at two of the foundational texts for both Judaism and Christianity: the *Shema* from Deuteronomy 6; “*You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might*” (v. 5) and Jesus’ second Commandment from Mark 12: “*You shall love your neighbor as yourself*” (v. 31b).

It is no secret that we humans struggle to live out these commandments—both individually and communally as a society. We will explore some examples of people who overcame the barriers of fear and mistrust to establish flourishing communities of reconciliation and hope, so as to gain practical insight for our own lives. I look forward to sharing this hope-filled message with you!
