

Frequently Asked Questions about May Worship at DCPC

May 17th- 8:30 a.m. only, in the Sanctuary, live-streamed (so you can worship later if you prefer).

Why do we only have one service of worship? We lease our building from Davidson College. A condition of our lease is that we will not have a worship service at the same time as their commencement, which is 10:00 a.m. on May 17th. Besides, we do NOT want to compete for parking that day!

May 24th- 8:30 a.m., in the Sanctuary, live-streamed. **10:30 a.m.** at the Davidson College Lake Campus, not live-streamed.

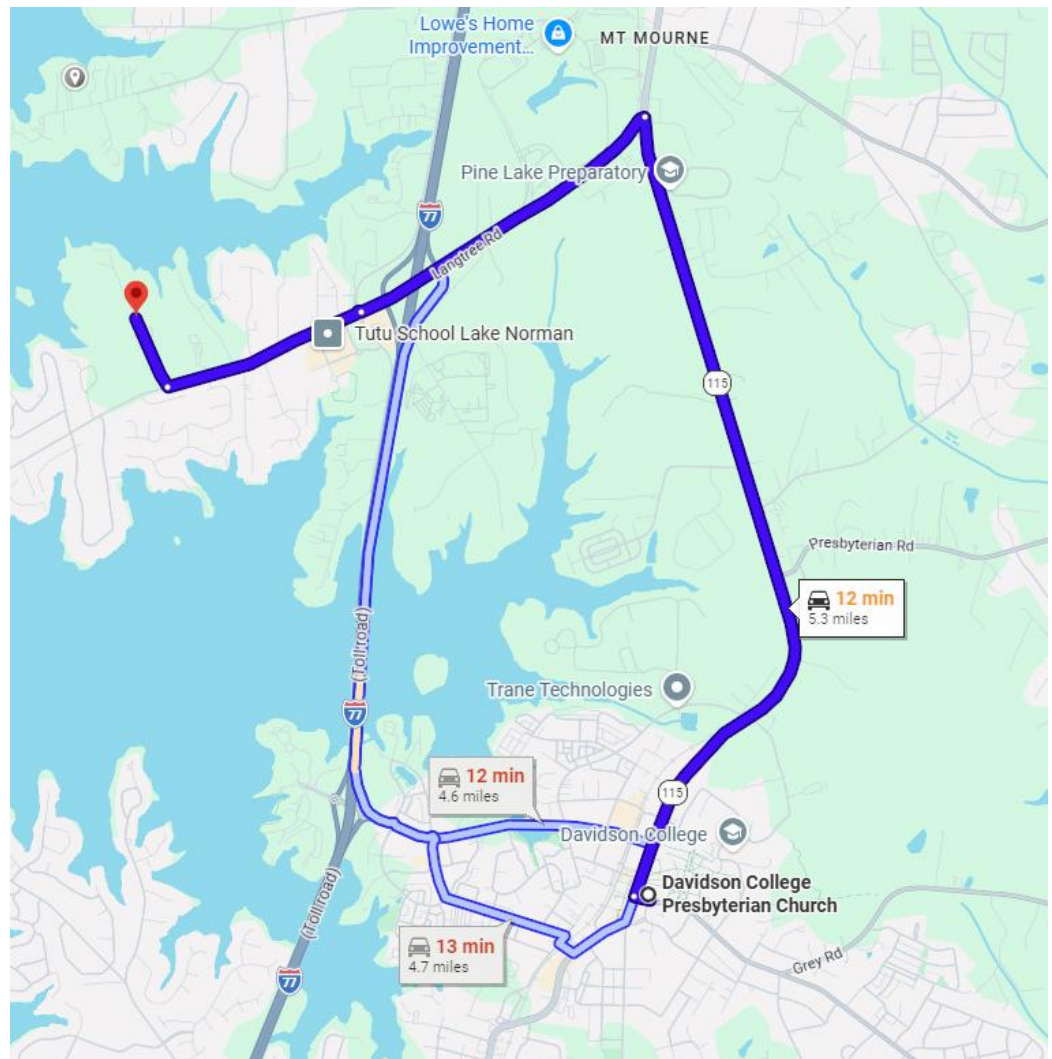
Why are we worshipping at the Lake Campus? It is Pentecost, the day we celebrate the gift of the Spirit, often symbolized by wind. What better place to seek that wind than at the lake? Also, it is Memorial Day weekend with fewer people in worship. And people in town like to cookout and enjoy the lake, which has few public access points.

Where is the Davidson College Lake Campus? Located off of I-77 exit 31, one exit north of Davidson. 152 Lake Campus Drive, Mooresville, 28117

How do I get there?

You can drive. Just go through the gate, down the gravel road and turn left into the gravel parking lot. We will have signs and greeters. The Pines will have a shuttle; look for the card put in your box. And DCPC will run a shuttle from the Main Building. It will leave from the church at 9:30 and 10:00 and then from the Lake Campus at 10:45 and 11:15. We may add other

departure times from the lake campus if we can get the drivers.



Will there be a bus from the Pines? Yes, the Bus will be leaving the Pines at 10am and will return after Service.

What do I bring? Camp chairs or blankets if you can. We will have some chairs available for those who cannot bring them, plus some picnic tables. If you are staying for lunch, bring it with you. DCPC will have coolers of water and the Handel's ice cream truck will be scooping ice cream: the first 100 scoops are free!

How do I dress? We are outside at the lake. Super casual!

What else? The lake campus will open at 10:00 a.m. and is available for our use until 2:00. After worship you can picnic, swim, and we will also have kites, and inflatables.

What happens if it rains? We have a Sanctuary for worship and a Congregation House for ice cream. We will notify everyone on Saturday if the weather looks inclement.

May 31st - 10:00 only in the Sanctuary, live-streamed.

This is the start of our third summer of 10:00 only services. It is a chance for worshipers from our three different services to be together on Sunday mornings. We will keep this schedule through September 6. There is no Sunday school, per se, except the Maloney Bible Class for adults will still meet and there will be some limited-run adult offerings from time to time. Worship in the summer includes lemonade outside and on June 14, 21, and 28, we will worship outside in front of the Sanctuary. But that is a whole other FAQ!
