#### **The Long Ride**

Dear Friends,

This past Sunday was my birthday. Thank you for your good wishes. It was a funday. My family asked me what I wanted to do for the day and they all indulged me in a long ride - a long bike ride! I had been wanting to go with everyone on some of the greenways around Cornelius and Davidson and so we pumped up the tires and filled our water bottles and off we went.

I noticed early on that we would have a challenge keeping everyone together. Not everyone rides at the same pace. each one wants to take, and let's make sure we can wait long enough for folks to catch up. Let's stay in this together and make sure that everyone gets home safely!
