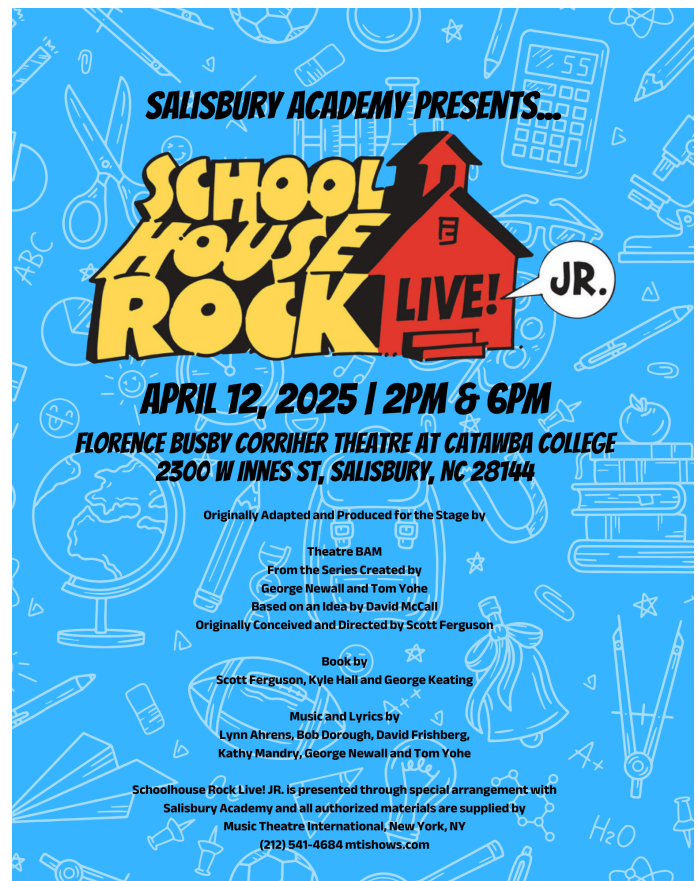

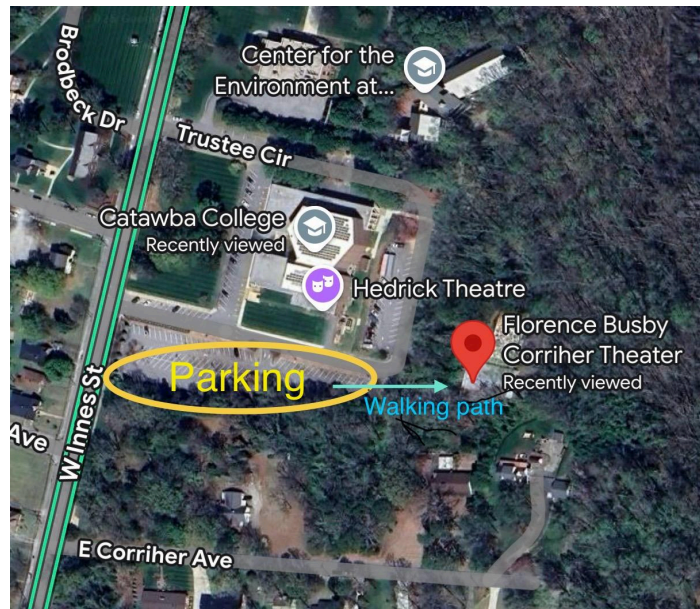

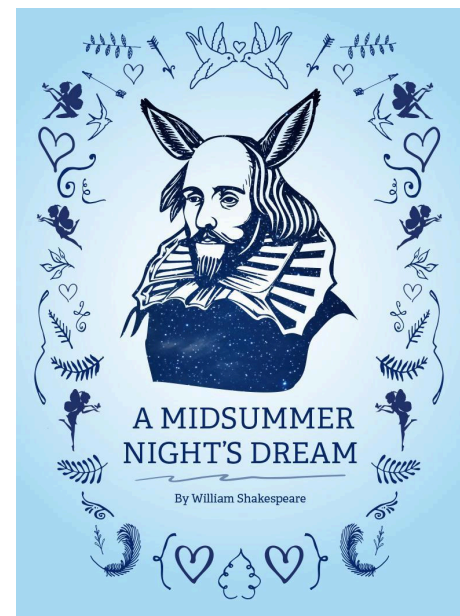


COMMUNITY ART HAPPENINGS:
