#### Student Self-Referrals

One of the most important attributes of an effective school counselor is to be accessible! With so many students and only one of me, I have made it super simple for students to make self-referrals whenever they are feeling BIG feelings. Lower school has a letter/mailbox system I check daily to make sure anyone who needs extra support gets in in a timely manner. Middle and Upper School have access to a Google Form in their Google Classroom that sends me a notification instantly.

## Novant Telepsychiatry Partnership

Salisbury Academy has officially secured a partnership with Novant designed to address needs related to mental health services. You can think of it like VIP access to services such as Crisis/Inpatient Stabilization, Behavioral Health Assessments, Safety Planning, Case Management, and Bridge Therapy Support. We are lucky to be the ONLY school in Rowan County to offer this access. Did I mention these services are completely free to our families? Because, they are!





#### Mini-Academies

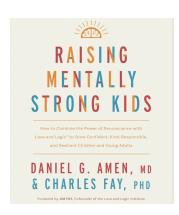
