See You at the Pole, the global day of student prayer, began in 1990 as a grassroots movement with ten students praying at their school. Decades later, millions pray on their campuses on the fourth Wednesday in September.

See You at the Pole is simply a prayer rally where students meet at the school flagpole before school to lift up their friends, families, teachers, school, and nation to God. See You at the Pole™ is a student-initiated, student-organized, and student-led event.

Canvas Workshops grade 3-8

These works will be fired, and the students will get to glaze the works using a variety of techniques. Pumpkins will be returned before Thanksgiving, and the rest of the projects will be returned to students the week of Dec 1.
