- The EFP is open 9:30-12:30 Monday through Friday, and the third Saturday of the month.
- The EFP is the largest direct-to-client food assistance agency in Dauphin County, providing emergency food assistance to more than 2,300 people living in the greater Harrisburg area each month.
- The EFP is committed to demonstrating compassion and respect for all members of its diverse client base.
- The EFP provides clients with meat, eggs, butter, bread, milk, fresh produce, a variety of nonperishable foods, and personal care items when available.
