Seth Adzokatse will be visiting us in the Milwaukee Presbytery June 20 to 25, 2019, on their way to attend the Ghana Mission Network Meeting in Erie, PA. We are planning opportunities for them to experience church life in our presbytery, see what our mission ministries are doing locally, nationally and internationally, as well as share stories from congregations within their Presbytery.

We have activities planned for their time within our Presbytery, and also have preaching opportunities at Calvary, in downtown Milwaukee, and Beaver Dam, Grace. If your church is having an activity you'd like our guests to attend or if you would like to plan a meal, let us know. We would welcome any and all of you to join us.

At the end of their stay, the two ministers will take part in the Ghana Mission Network meeting which is being hosted by the Lake Erie Presbytery in Erie, PA.
