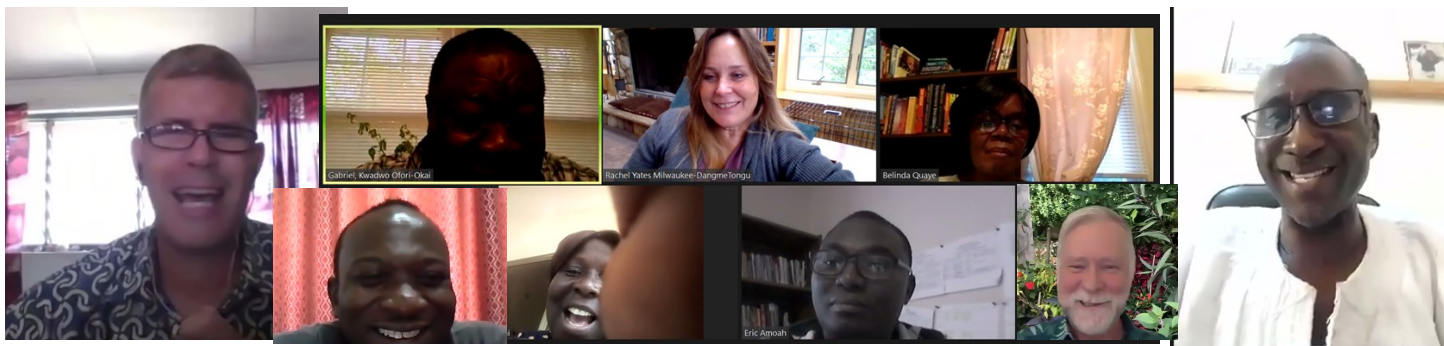

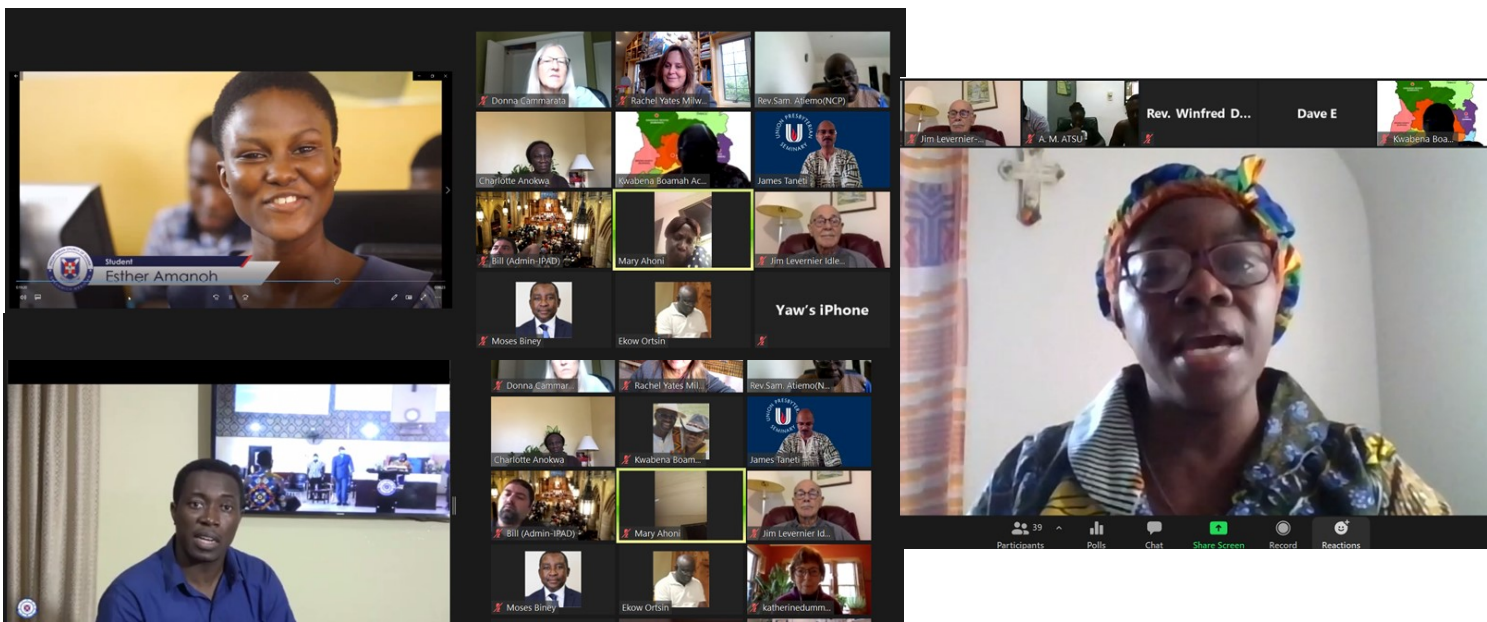
THE GATHERING
