Is college the right choice for you? This panel presentation is an interactive discussion that will provide information, including academic and social experiences, for students who have IEP's or 504 plans. Representatives and students from area colleges will talk about the differences between high school and college and how support services are delivered. They will suggest steps to take when you are planning to attend college.
