



CJ SPIRIT WEEK GUIDELINES – 2019

Teachers –

Please read all of these guidelines to your students and then, please post!

**** REMINDER!!** If students do not dress in the theme of the day, they **MUST** wear their uniform. Violations of these guidelines will result in an After School Detention or a Saturday Detention as determined by OSS, and students will be asked to change clothes.

****During LUNCH** in the Cafeteria all week during SPIRIT WEEK, Student Council Spirit Committee Members will give out **PRIZES** to anyone who is the **BEST DRESSED** according to the Spirit Week Theme of the Day! **WOO HOO!!**

IN GENERAL: These general rules should be read EVERY DAY with the Spirit Theme Rules!!

- No t-shirts with Alcohol, Tobacco/cigarettes, Bad words, or Drug references on them
- No “Short” shorts – they must be mid-thigh – no Daisy Dukes! – they must not be more than 3-4 inches above the knee
- No “Short” skirts – they must not be more than 3-4 inches above the knee
- No bare midriffs, tube tops, or halter tops, no sleeveless shirts, and no tank tops – - No part of the stomach should be exposed. No low cut shirts that show too much cleavage.
- No sunglasses & no flip-flops (except faculty / staff for Tropical Thursday!)
- No swimwear
- No stiletto heels & no open-toed shoes
- If leggings are worn, they **MUST** be covered. They cannot be worn by themselves. What is worn over the leggings **CANNOT** be more than 3-4 inches above the knee
- No SPANDEX or extremely **TIGHT / FORM-FITTING** Clothing
- Students need to respect their teachers and if teachers want hats or headgear off while in class & lunch, then students need to abide by what their teachers want
- **NOTHING INAPPROPRIATE!!!**
- Sweat pants are allowed
- Athletic shorts are allowed as long as they are no more than 3-4 inches above the knee
- Students will be asked to change or parents will be called to bring in appropriate clothing. If it is questionable, **DON’T WEAR IT!!**

CJ SPIRIT WEEK 2019

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2019 – MASQUERADE MONDAY (Halloween!)

- Students may wear Halloween costumes or Halloween clothing appropriate for the school setting or their shirts may be ORANGE OR BLACK
- Masks that go along with your costume are allowed to be worn but must be removed during class & lunch - Hats must go along with your costume. If it does not, then you cannot wear a hat!

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2019 - THROWBACK TUESDAY - 1980s Style!

- **Dress in clothing from the 1980's!** Think of neon colors, baggy clothes, leg warmers, off the shoulder sweatshirts, stone washed jeans & jean jackets, big hair, parachute pants, jellies, etc

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2019 – WACKY WEDNESDAY

- Students may dress in clothing that does not match or does not normally go together (ex. Plaids with stripes, polka dots with plaids, 2 different shoes and 2 different socks, colors that don't match, etc...)
- Wearing two different BRANDS of clothing does NOT count as mismatch!
- Mismatch clothing, crazy socks & crazy makeup are allowed

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2019 – CLASS UNITY DAY

SENIOR CITIZENS: Seniors may wear clothing that represents what Older People would be seen in such as gray wigs, robes or housecoats over your regular clothes, slippers, orthopedic shoes, older looking clothing, etc. Canes or walkers ARE allowed as long as they are used properly and are not used to disrupt the daily flow of our school day

JOCK JUNIORS: Students may dress as FAN FANATICS for their favorite sports team - grade school, high school, college, professional, or intramurals - or as an athlete. The sports team may be professional or amateur and Shirts MUST represent a real team - Hats ARE allowed if they represent a sports team but faculty members may ask students NOT to wear headgear in the classroom

- Athletic shorts that are no more than 3-4 inches above the knee & sweatpants ARE allowed
- Outfits can be anything that represents SPORTS, Sports Teams, or Sports Television

SUPER SOPHOMORES - Students may dress as their favorite superhero OR students may dress in a shirt or in pants with their favorite superhero on it

- Masks that go along with your character are allowed to be worn but must be removed during class & lunch
- Hats must go along with your character. If it does not, then you cannot wear a hat!

FARMER FRESHMAN - Students may dress in WESTERN / COWBOY/ COWGIRL clothing or in FARMER clothing such as Bib overalls, John Deere Clothing, Plaid work shirts, denim shirts, boots, etc.

- Hats ARE allowed as long as they are FARMER, WESTERN, or COWBOY HATS

TROPICAL TEACHERS / STAFF - Outfits can be BEACHY, Tropical, Hawaiian, etc.

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2019 – CJ BLUE / GREEN SPIRIT DAY

- Students may dress in CJ Spirit Clothing

- Students' shirts MUST be predominantly CJ blue, CJ green, CJ blue & green, or an official CJ top
- CJ Sponsored (Clubs & Athletics) Blue, Green, Gray, White, or Black shirts are allowed if they are OFFICIAL CJ sponsored shirts
- Homemade shirts can be CJ blue or CJ green or white ONLY. No other color can be used for Homemade shirts
- JEANS DO NOT COUNT as "blue" for spirit
- Students may wear jeans or shorts with their CJ spirit shirt. Jeans must be in good repair. CJ Tattoos and Hair Color ARE allowed as long as they go along with the CJ Spirit Theme. Hats ARE allowed as long as they are OFFICIAL CJ HATS and must be removed during class & lunch if teachers want them off.
- CJ warm-up pants, CJ sweatpants, or solid blue or green sweatpants with no writing are allowed.
- Athletic shorts are allowed as long as they are no more than 3-4 inches above the knee
