Applications for Pre-College Summer 2021 Programs are available NOW!

The University of Illinois Chicago (UIC) - **CHANCE Program** is offering summer pre-college programming that will jumpstart high school students into their college careers. Open to **current** High School Students, our summer programs are focused in the area(s): **COMPUTER SCIENCE (CS), BUSINESS, ENGINEERING, and MOBILE APP DEVELOPMENT & DESIGN**. Students with a sincere interest in industry-related college instruction and **attending UIC after graduation** are strongly encouraged to apply.

All programs will take place **VIRTUALLY** from June 28 - July 30, 2021.

Classes meet daily Monday - Friday, begin at 9:00 am and conclude at 1:00 pm.

Students **must have** a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale and be available for **the ENTIRE** 5-week camp.

General Information:

- ✓ Students can earn College Credit upon successful completion and **ENROLLMENT** at UIC.
- ✓ Internship opportunities are available after the 2nd year of enrollment at UIC.
- ✓ Upon enrollment at UIC, students are eligible for **partial and full-ride scholarships**.
- ✓ Participate in **Friday Enrichment Days**, which will be held in conjunction with Fortune 500 companies and other organizations across Chicago.
- ✓ Students work in conjunction with UIC English Instructors to improve their writing skills.
- ✓ Program is offered at no cost to the student.

Camp Highlights:



The Digital Scholars - Computer Science Summer Program affords high school sophomores, juniors, seniors and ENTERING UIC Students access to computer aided design projects and offers students "hands-on" training to "real-world settings." The intensive curriculum provides an opportunity for students to learn computer-science instruction from UIC Professors and Professionals who will help students solve problems and encourage scientific innovation.

In partnership with the University of Illinois - **Discovery Partners Institute**, students will also have access to Professionals within the computer science fields and participate in daily speaker series aimed to engage and encourage their interest in computer science. Students have an opportunity to earn College Credit in CS 100 (Discovering Computer Science) or CS 111 (Program Design I)



The STEM Academy Program is designed to prepare students seeking access to careers in the STEM fields. Our goal to educate, empower, and prepare "Rising Seniors," for access to Careers in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math).

In partnership with the **UIC College of Engineering** and **ComEd**, our rigorous e-Learning programming promises to afford students access to engaging activities, project-based learning, and interactive sessions with live instruction. Students have an opportunity to earn College Credit in an Engineering Math course.



Our Future Leaders in Business Program is offered in partnership with the **UIC Business** and is designed for rising high school seniors. The goal of this Five-week program is to expose participants to the University of Illinois Chicago campus and offer comprehensive programming in leadership development and career exploration while receiving academic instruction in the core business areas of: accounting, finance, marketing, and management.
