Authorization (if applicable) does NOT guarantee payment of benefits for these services. Coverage is subject to all limits and exclusions outlined in the members plan and/or summary plan description included in the plan documents.

When diagnosing **substance use disorders**, here are some helpful tips:

2. PCP is categorized as **hallucinogens**
3. Benzodiazepines are categorized under **Sedative, Hypnotic or Anxiolytic Disorders**

**\*All tips apply to Medical Diagnoses as well.**

ICD-10-CM "Z" codes are applicable for social determinants of health. They are found under Diagnostic Categories **Factors Influencing Health Status and Housing**.
