We will be collecting any of the requested items to help stock the food pantry of 7th Street Bistro of Memorial West United Presbyterian Church which will enable 7th Street Bistro to expand their food ministry. Memorial West United Presbyterian Church and The First Presbyterian Church at Caldwell are both members of The Presbytery of the Northeast.

Requested items:

- Pinto Beans, Red Beans, Kidney Beans, Vegetarian Beans
- Vegetable Soup, Tomato Soup, Cream of Chicken/Mushroom Soup
- Tuna Fish, Sardines, Pink Salmon, Chicken (canned)
- Peanut Butter, Grape or Strawberry Jelly/Jam,
- Assorted Canned Fruit (Pears, Pineapple, Peaches Apple Sauce (or Mixed Fruit)
- Dried Raisins, Cranberries, Craisins, prunes
- Canned Vegetables: Green Beans, Greens, Peas and Carrots, Corn, Spinach, Mixed Vegetables
- Sugar, Flour, Hamburger Helper, Cooking Oil
- Any Canned Juices
- Jiffy Corn Meal Mix
- Cold Cereals, Various, Low sugar
- Instant Oatmeal, Variety Pack
- Pop Tarts
