Call to Artists

- All Tampa Bay area artists with a passion for architecture, design and music are invited to enter the 2nd Annual TBFAD 'ART on HART'. The program is made possible with support from the Gasparilla Music Foundation and the Vinik Family Foundation.
- The submission receipt deadline is 5:00 p.m., Friday, November 15, 2019.

TBFAD 'ART on HART' will take place for the majority of the calendar year of 2020 and will feature a thirty five foot long clean diesel public bus acting as a rolling canvas in and throughout Hillsborough County.

Johann Wolgang von Goethe stated, 'Music is liquid architecture; Architecture is frozen music.' Entries should be an artistic representation of how music influences the built environment while encouraging respect for others. Artists are encouraged to incorporate Tampa Bay's wide diversity of design, architecture, and musical culture into their submission; however, artists are discouraged from using "Gasparilla" themes such as pirates or beads. Please do NOT include any sponsors or their subsidiaries name or logo in the artwork; doing so will disqualify the entry. If chosen, sponsor branding will be incorporated to the final version by TBFAD.

Entries will be judged by an expert panel of judges and the TBFAD 'ART on HART' Committee. HART employees will make the final decision to select the winning entry. Submissions will be evaluated based on concept, originality, lay out and marketing adaptability.

The winning artist will receive:

- A \$2,000 cash award
- Featured bio in the TBFAD 'ART on HART' printed program
- Recognition on TBFAD & participating organizations social media sites.

GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY

- The TBFAD 'ART on HART' is open to all artists residing in the Tampa Bay region.
- Limit to one entry per artist. Entries must be an original art piece (any medium) that is production-ready, horizontal poster format and digitally submitted.
- Canvas size must scale to 24"x36".
- Each entry, artist must include their printed name, address, phone number and email address.
