SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Minimum eligibility requirements:

- Admission to a graduate public health certificate or MPH degree program
- U.S. citizenship
- 3.0 GPA
- Current or future career in public health

Scholarship funding priority is for residents of Kansas, K-State current students, and future K-State students who will relocate to Kansas.
