What your school will receive under this sponsorship

- Each Colorado school that is accepted into this program will receive the full series of No Bully leadership coaching, teacher trainings and parent workshops in how to implement the No Bully System® to prevent and stop student bullying and harassment.
- ESPN X Games will support Colorado schools with star power to connect with local students through a school assemblies, collateral materials and incentives
- Each school will be fully funded for a one-year No Bully partnership (\$15,000 value) that begins in the fall and runs through June 2018.
- ESPN X Games has a preference for supporting middle and high schools in Colorado, though some elementary schools may be considered for measurement of district-wide impact and inclusion of feeder schools.
