WHAT ARE COLLEGE ACCESS PROFESSIONAL TRAININGS?

The Arizona College Access Network's (AzCAN) College Access Professional (CAP) Trainings are for professionals who help students prepare for and be successful in postsecondary education.

HOW ARE THE COURSES STRUCTURED?

The courses are Arizona-specific and include scholarly readings, online discussions with peers and assignments that culminate in an action plan. Participants earn recertification hours for successful completion of each course, but more importantly, will be able to create a plan that contributes to the college-going culture of their school or organization.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

CAP trainings are open to all college access professionals in Arizona including:

- Superintendents
