0600 – 0700 **Breakfast. MANDATORY FOR ALL FOURTH CLASS CADETS (-modified Sit-down)** (no guests allowed)

0900 - 0945 **Cadet Aviation Capabilities Exercise (CAPEX) and Pre-Parade Demonstrations** (*Stillman Field*). Watch the USAFA Wings of Blue parachute team, your National Champion glider team and Air Force Academy powered flight aircraft as they demonstrate the various cadet-led aviation and leadership development programs that cadets are offered during time at USAFA.

0945 – 1045 **Cadet Wing Parade** (*Stillman Field*). **MANDATORY FOR ALL CADETS**. Arrive early for pre-parade demonstrations. At the parade, the **2019 Distinguished Service Award** will be presented. Cadets will be released on the field to meet with their guests. If the parade is cancelled for severe weather, guests may visit the Information Fair at Arnold Hall or check with their cadet to see whether their Squadron will move up their Open House.

1100 – 1230 **Noon Meal** (*provided by Mitchell Hall, various other locations*). Lunch at Mitchell Hall will need to be available for any Cadet who does not wish to purchase food from Food Trucks or other sources. *If Cadets wish to bring family/quests to Mitchell hall, they must purchase quest tickets in advance.* Lunch is also available in the Squadron Quads, Field House, Visitor Center, Falcon Club, and Arnold Hall. Food trucks will be available near Squadron picnic areas to feed parents (prices vary between vendors).

1100 – 1630 **Parents' Weekend Information Fair** (*Arnold Hall*). Offers invaluable information and giveaways from many USAFA and cadet organizations. Information Booths will be set up from the Commandant of Cadets, Cadet Clubs, Cadet Sponsor Program, Dean of Faculty, Athletic Department, 306th Flying Training Group, 10 FSS Support Services and various USAFA Support Groups. Preorder your BCT yearbook. Lunch can be purchased in the Richter Lounge.

1100 - 1500 **Center for Character and Leadership Development Open** (*Polaris Hall*). Meet at Arnold Hall entrance. Cadets and their guests.

1100 - 1630 **Athletics Open House** (*Cadet Gymnasium*). Cadets and their guests are welcome to visit the cadet gymnasium and meet the athletics staff and learn all about the many athletic programs available at USAFA.

1230 – 1630 **Airfield Open House** (*USAFA Airfield*). Come view static displays of USAFA aircraft and parachuting equipment and visit with the staff of the 306th Flying Training Group. Cadets must escort their guests to the airfield.

1400 – 1600 **Prep School Football vs. USAFA Junior Varsity** (*TurfField*).

1630 – 1800	<u>Squadron Open Houses</u> (<i>Vandenberg and Sijan Halls</i>). MANDATORY FOR FOURTH-CLASS CADETS.
