Jehovah's Witnesses was Started in Pennsylvania in 1870 as a Bible study class taught by Charles T. Russell


- 8,579,909— Jehovah's Witnesses

Jehovah's Witnesses	Evangelicals
God Jehovah Witnesses reject the Trinity. Jesus was created by Jehovah, and "holy spirit" is an impersonal force	God The Triune God exists eternally as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
Jesus The highest created being of Jehovah; also known as Michael the archangel	Jesus The second person of the Trinity and the Savior of the world through His sacrifice upon the cross
Scripture The New World Translation of the Bible  The Watchtower Magazine	Scripture The Bible
Salvation Based on faith and works. However, only 144,000 faithful believers will be saved and go to heaven.	Salvation By grace through faith in Jesus Christ
Hell People who are not saved by Jehovah will pass out of existence. Therefore, there is not a literal place of eternal punishment.	Hell The place of everlasting punishment for those not saved by the blood of Jesus.
Man A created species by Jehovah, endowed with free will to live by faith and Jehovah's undeserved kindness	Man A created species by God through the Son Jesus Christ to bring glory to God
