But British author and humorist P.G. Wodehouse, creator of the hilarious characters of Jeeves, Bertie Wooster, and the denizens of the Drones Club, used the term in one of his novels to signify something that brought bad luck. And bad luck descended on St Andrew's shortly after the last meeting recorded in the notebook, which included the sum earned from the sale of Skidoo. Due to a failure to pay its diocesan assessment, the church was demoted from the status of parish to that of mission.
