In this session participants will learn the practices of seeking, naming, and celebrating God's presence in our daily life and the lives of those

The Beloved Community StorySharing Campaign seeks to help faith communities and individuals to share and receive stories of faith, race, and difference and to become more effective healers, reconcilers, and ambassadors of Christ in the world. Rev. Nancy Frausto will share how Episcopal churches can explore and practice StorySharing within their congregations, between different Episcopal congregations near and far, and with friends, family, neighbors, and with civic partners in order to begin to bridge the gap between communities.
