Calling Down Fire! Teilhard's Mass on the World Online Retreat

The day will come when, after harnessing space, the winds, the tides, and gravitation, we shall harness for God the energies of love. And on that day, for the second time in the history of the world, we shall have discovered fire--*Pierre Teilhard de Chardin*.

An intense enlivening fire! That is how Teilhard saw Christ. A fire present in all matter and all creation--penetrating, renewing, evolving. As a Jesuit priest and world-renowned paleontologist, Teilhard had a heart consumed with love for Jesus Christ, love for humanity and love for creation. In his stunningly poetic and heart-penetrating *Mass on the World*, written at a time when he did not have access to the usual Eucharistic elements, Teilhard summoned as his communal elements humankind, growth, and diminishment; all tenderly held in the glowing fire of Christ's love. The first hour will provide a brief look at Teilhard's life and works to give context for the *Mass on the World*. Our last hour will be a meditative video rendering and reading of his *Mass on the World*.
