

FAST OF THE 17th OF TAMUZ

This Motzei Shabbos begins the mourning period known as the Three Weeks. mourning restrictions begin immediately after Shabbos. However, the fast does not begin until dawn on Sunday morning. The fast begins at 4:23am (stict) / 4:40am (lenient). We will have minyanim three Shacharis the usual 5:26/7:30/8:30am. Mincha will be at 1:35 and 7:35pm (there will not be a 5:35pm Mincha). Rabbi Stern will offer words of reflection at 8:10pm. Maariv will be at 8:25pm. The fast will end at 8:41pm (lenient), 8:46pm (strict).

ASPECTS OF MOURNING DURING THE THREE WEEKS

- No weddings are held. (However, engagement ceremonies are permitted.)
- We do not listen to music.
- We avoid all public celebrations -- especially those which involve dancing and musical accompaniment.
- We avoid exciting and entertaining trips and activities. (Kaf HaChaim OC 551:41)
- No haircuts or shaving. (Fingernails may be clipped up until the week in which Tisha B'Av falls.)
- We do not say the blessing Shehechianu on new food or clothes, except on Shabbat.
