hold it close.

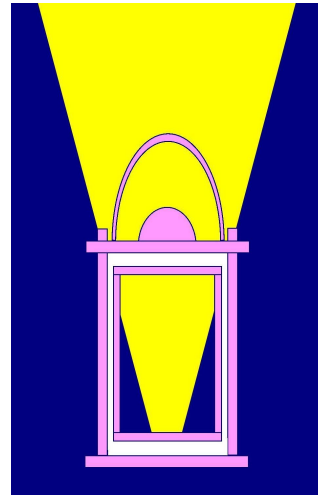
come, Christ, come.
