Apprenticeship Program

Youth Apprenticeship Program

Students completing their junior year of high school and interested in starting a skilled trades career can take part in our state-certified Youth Apprenticeship Program, which teaches trade fundamentals and provides credit towards the full-time Apprenticeship Program upon graduation. This program allows the student and Schaeffler to determine together if this career path is the right fit.

Candidate requirements

- High School Diploma or GED. Note: Youth apprentices must have their completed junior year of high school
- Maintain passing grades in all job-related classes that focus on the specific trade
- Maintain established performance standards
- Complete a background check and pre-employment drug screening
