


- Training, curriculum, and on-site support from a Program Coordinator are provided by Heart Tutoring.



The Need

Without intervention, scores decline as course complexity increases. Gaps can be addressed through hands-on activities with tutors.



Program Outcomes

- \triangleright 98% of over 2,400 students to date have met program growth goals in math set with guidance from elementary math specialists at UNCC and CMS.
- ▶ 92% of teachers observed an increase in student confidence/enthusiasm toward math as a result of Heart, and 63% reported students are more confident in subjects other than math.
