What is a Residency License?

A residency license is an alternative pathway to teaching that allows qualified individuals to obtain a teaching position and begin teaching right away, while obtaining a professional educator's license. It is a one-year license, renewable twice.

FIND YOUR PATH

Qualifications:

1. Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education
2. Completed coursework relevant to the requested licensure area (24+ semester hours) OR passed the content area examination relevant to the requested licensure area that has been approved by the State Board of Education
3. Hold a minimum of 2.7 grade point average

How to Apply:

2. Fill out the online application and upload all of your official degree-dated transcripts to the Attachments section of your application. If you have passing score reports on the NCSBE exams and/or proof of enrollment in an EPP, upload that as well.
3. Apply to the Teacher, Alternative License Pathway (All Subjects) job posting.
4. We will review your application and you will receive an email with next steps.
