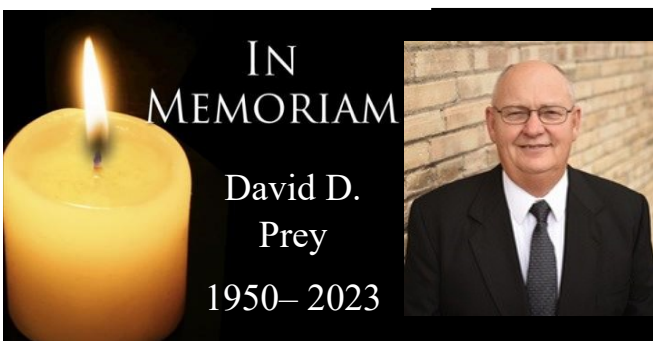
Greetings from Navarino Nature Center-

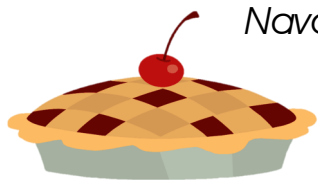

Sunset with the Sandhill Cranes

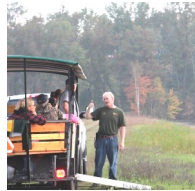

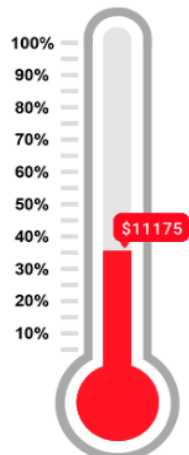
