

YEL Safe Summer 2020 June Online Course Options



Since school closures began in mid-March, YEL has offered over 50 free and paid online webinars to over 1,000 students. Those webinars have received a 4.55 out of 5.00 parent rating on 197 responses. Some things to note about YEL Online Classes:

- 1. All classes are live and interactive. We have expert panelists (teachers) with a vast knowledge of the subject we are teaching.
- 2. Each class has two or more adult instructors. The expert panelist and an organizer who answers student questions and structures each class.
- 3. Classes are available to all community partners. Your regional director (who emailed this to you) will send you a schedule of online classes.
- 4. These classes are fun. Kids have a great time and learn a lot.
- 5. Most classes do not require direct parent oversight. We have seen that in most cases, once parents get the GoTo Meeting app started on their computer, they are free to loosely monitor the child.

FAQ

- Who takes registration?
 - Community partners overwhelmingly prefer to take their own registration. We have set up a system to allow that.
- What system do you use for online webinars?
 - Currently we use GoTo Meeting and GoTo Webinar. We are exploring other options as well.
- How do parents join the meeting?
 - We will email parents a link to the online classroom (a GoToMeeting link).
- Does YEL contact parents directly?
 - It is much easier and more effective for YEL to email parents directly. Handling the myriad questions parents have leading up to each class (How do I get my ChessKid.com account? Can I use a laptop? What's my child's Scratch password) is a challenge. Adding a go-between just adds unnecessary work to everyone's plate and the possibility of important information getting missed increases. For that reason, YEL advises our community partners to allow us to email parents directly. To do this, we will need parent names and email addresses.
- How do community partners schedule these classes?
 - We have limited capacity (see min/max for each class below), so our regional directors are reaching out to clients to schedule the classes.
 - We have flexibility of adding more classes in the afternoon, if parent demand requires it.
- Do you plan on doing online classes in July and August?
 - Yes. We will have a similar course schedule to what is below for July and August.
- Do you have plans in place for online classes in the fall?
 - Yes. We are in the beginning stages of planning online classes for fall. We want to partner with communities to help them keep kids engaged whether inschool, or online.

Footnotes for above columns:

- 1. Topic This is the topic of the online class.
- 2. Time Slots We are offering 2-3 time slots each day. Each time slot is a different group of students. Some classes have different levels (chess, for instance) with each time slot. We are not able to adjust the time slots at this time. NOTE: The Free Chess Tournaments are only on Thursdays from 1-3pm.
 - 2.1. Project Runway is 90 minutes in length.
- 3. Days We are running these classes Mondays through Thursdays for each week offered.
- 4. Course Name NOTE: if you offer these classes, the brand {YEL!} must appear in the course title and in the course description where present.
- 5. Min/Max The minimum enrollment to run the class. Because we are offering these classes to multiple communities, it is more likely that each class will run. That is why we have a minimum of zero for all classes.
 - 5.1. We will be in constant communication with community partners about current standing of registration and if we need to close registration because we have reached the maximum.
- 6. Ages These are the recommended ages for each class. In some cases, it differs from our live, in-person ages due to the additional challenges of online classes.
- 7. Description A description of each class.
- 8. Notes and Supplies Some classes require an online account (Scratch for Coding, ChessKid.com for chess). Some classes require at home supplies (Magic). Some may require the parent purchase materials (Project Runway). Any of the necessary supplies or other notes is included in this section.
- 9. Dates As of now, we are offering each class to run in the time slots designated for the days of Monday through Thursday. We have three weeks of camps right now (we are in the planning stages for July, August, and fall options): June 15-18; June 22-25; June 29-July 2.
- 10. YEL Fee This is the fee that YEL will charge our community partners for each child who signs up from their community.
- 11. Community Partners Fee This is the recommended fee for our community partners. We suggest that all communities have the same fee so that parents see the same class for the same fee on Community A's website as they do on Community B's website. The \$30 to YEL and \$8 to community partners is a 79%/21% split. Project Runway is a 82%/18% split.
- 12. Total Parent Fee What the parent will pay to participate.
