From points West

Long Island Expressway (495) East to Exit 71 At Stop Sign (Edwards Avenue) Turn Left Proceed 4 miles to Sound Avenue Right turn onto Sound 1-1/4 miles Turn Left on to Warner Drive Club Drive approximately 1/4 mile on left.

From Southampton and points East

Sunrise Highway (27) to Exit 64N (Route 104 North) 4 miles to Circle Continue straight (follow sign to Rte 25) 1 block to light Left onto West Main, then right at 2nd Light onto Osborn 1/2 miles to Sound Avenue Turn left on to Sound Avenue Proceed 1/4 mile to Warner Drive Turn Right Entrance approximately 1/4 mile on left.

Covid-19 Procedures Reminders:

- One player per cart rule. Members from the same household may ride together. (If you come in the same car, you can ride in the same cart).
- Strict golf cart disinfecting procedures will be done after every round and a "CLEAN CART" tag will be placed on each cart after it has been disinfected. Remove this tag from your steering wheel and discard when starting your round.
- After your round, drive your clubs to your car and return your cart to the designated area. We don't want used carts to be accidentally mixed in by the flagpole.
- "Keep the flag in at all times" will be the new policy to minimize handling the flagstick. Holes have been shallowed to make it easy to retrieve your ball with out touching cup or flagstick.
- Rakes are removed from course (smooth traps with feet or clubhead). Lift, clean & place rule for all bunkers.
- Ball washers are removed from golf course.
- Balls will be set up on range in range boxes – no hands to set balls up.
- Participants are asked to refrain from gathering in groups on the golf course and to respect the social distancing protocol at all times.
- The halfway house bathrooms (by the 10th tee) will be open and disinfected regularly.

Once again, we expect everyone to follow these rules to do our part in reducing the spread. We are all in this together...
