

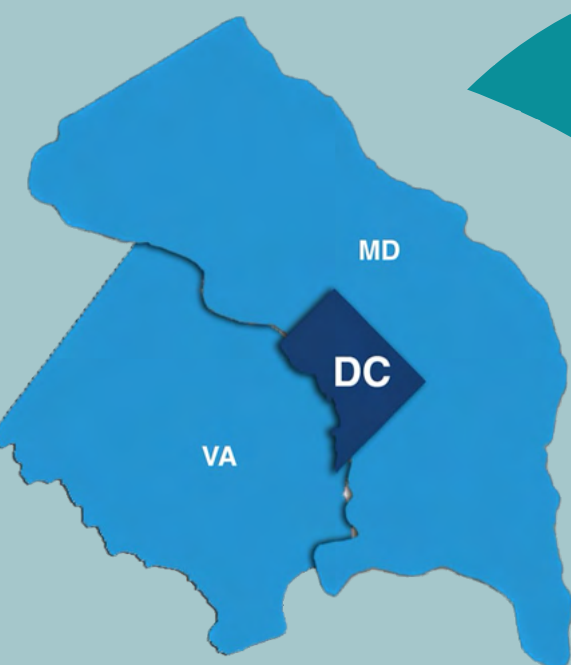

Don't ignore Breast Cancer because you think you're "too young" to get it. Screen early to catch Breast Cancer so you can live a long, healthy life.



Breast Cancer in Black Women in the DMV

Many factors make it critical to screen before the general guideline of age 50.

42%

The DMV has the highest Breast Cancer death rate in the nation

Of black women diagnosed with Breast Cancer will die from it



Myth v. Truth

MYTH:
OW! It's gonna hurt

Screening mammograms are 15 mins and apply little to no pressure

TRUTH:
The earlier you know, the better your outcomes

There's a 99% survival rate when caught early (stage 0 & 1)

Black women are most likely to have triple negative Breast Cancer (TNBC), the most aggressive cancer type.

Mammogram Tips

1. Opt in for a clinical breast exam at your next physical
2. Talk to your doctor about your personal Breast Cancer risk
3. If doctor recommended, schedule a free to low-cost screening mammogram
