

## RECENT STATE OF FLORIDA GOVERNMENT ACTIONS

**Travel** | Executive Order [20-86](#) | In response to continued concerns of people fleeing to Florida from states with *shelter-in-place* orders and “substantial community spread,” Governor Desantis has required any visitor to Florida from an area with substantial community spread to isolate and quarantine for 14 days or the length of their stay (whichever is shorter). The order works with EO 20-82 to comprehensively require air and auto travelers from areas of substantial community spread to quarantine and adds the ability of and direction to law enforcement to conduct traffic check-points to identify, notify, and collect information from such visitors. As with EO 20-82, persons who have been in an area with substantial community spread are required to notify any person they have had direct physical contact with over the past 21 days. Finally, the order does not exempt airline employees, though military members and anyone traveling to aid in the emergency response are still exempted.

The order identifies Louisiana, specifically, as an area of substantial community spread, but the order is not limited to travelers from Louisiana.
