

## RECENT STATE OF FLORIDA GOVERNMENT ACTIONS

**Non-Essential Businesses Restricted in Specific Counties** | Executive Order [20-89](#) | With over 60 percent of Florida's COVID-19 cases in four counties, Governor Desantis has ordered that the following counties limit access to businesses and facilities that are not considered "essential": Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, and Monroe. Non-essential businesses are defined by the Miami-Dade County guidelines and have been adopted in the Governor's order as a baseline. County administrators are given the discretion to determine additional businesses that are "essential" to meet the community's needs. Essential services are still required to continue reasonable measures to avoid exposure to COVID-19 by sanitizing facilities and adhering to CDC social distancing guidelines.
