

RECENT STATE OF FLORIDA GOVERNMENT ACTIONS

Healthcare | Executive Order [20-72](#) | In an effort to conserve medical supplies and personal protective equipment, all health care practitioners in Florida are prohibited from conducting any “medically unnecessary, non-urgent or non-emergency procedure or surgery which, if delayed, does not place a patient’s immediate health, safety, or well-being at risk, or will, if delayed, not contribute to the worsening of a serious or life-threatening medical condition.” The prohibition includes dentistry (excluding pain relief and management of infection), endoscopy, most cataract and lens surgeries, some spine and orthopedic procedures, and cosmetic procedures.
