Accommodations/Check-In at Park MGM (if applicable) We are returning to Park MGM (3770 S. Las Vegas Blvd.) for the fifth year in a row.



On Sunday from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. PT, a designated Coaches vs. Cancer check-in area powered by Guardant Health will be available inside the room marked GREENWICH, which is located within the hotel's Conference Center on the first floor. This space will allow you to settle in after travel, join the check-in queue and comfortably wait for a room assignment. If you are arriving on





Sunday and will be near the hotel during the hospitality suite hours, we encourage you to stop by to initiate your check-in process with **Park MGM** at our private kiosk. As rooms become available, the hotel will provide keys on a first-come, first-served basis.

During this timeframe as well, golfers may collect their event apparel. If you are not staying at the hotel or are unable to visit during the 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. window, you may also retrieve your golfer apparel immediately following the Sunday night party.

Check-in time begins at 3 p.m., however, you may process your check-in upon arrival and store your luggage at the Bell Desk until your room is prepared.

Golf Course Transportation

On Monday and Tuesday mornings, your foursome will meet at the **Uber/Rideshare** staging area to board a bus departing for the golf course. (From the Lobby, locate the Uber/Rideshare sign and exit those doors.) For 9 a.m. shotgun starts, transportation to Cascata leaves promptly at 7 a.m., to Shadow Creek at 7:15 a.m. and to TPC Summerlin/Southern Highlands at 7:30 a.m. PT.

IMPORTANT: On Monday, the bellmen will have your golf clubs situated along the driveway. Please be sure to retrieve your clubs and place them on your designated bus.

You will be transported back to Park MGM after golf. Arrangements have been made to transfer golf clubs between courses after Monday's round.
