



Daily Prayer Guide

Sunday: From Lovelessness to Love – I pray my neighbors will encounter the light of Your love through the revelation of Jesus. (1 Jn. 4:9) May Your love grow more and more in their hearts turning their eyes to the beauty and comfort of a Father Who truly loves them. (Phil. 1:9) Fill them today with the astonishing love of Christ that they would discover and know You like never before. (Eph. 3:18) Write the truth that there is no power that could ever be found in the universe that can distance us from Your passionate love. (Rom. 8:39) Jesus, pour this love into the hearts of every one of my neighbors. Amen.

Monday: From Fear to Hope – Good Shepherd, I pray my neighbors will be sheep of Your pasture and not have to fear even the shadow of death. Be with them. Let Your goodness and Your love pursue my neighbors. (Ps. 23:1, 6) Be their strong tower and refuge and cause their heart not to be afraid. (Ps. 27:3) I pray my neighbors find hope under the shadow of Your wings. (Ps. 91:2) Protect my neighbors from harm. (Ps. 91:4) May my neighbors know “hope that does not disappoint” in knowing You; and Your poured out love within their hearts. (Rom. 5:5). Amen.

Tuesday: From False Identity to Identity in Christ – Father, I pray my neighbors will no longer find their identity defined by career, financial status, or any sins of the past. Today let them hear Your voice and listen with a broken and contrite heart. (Heb. 3:15; Ps. 51:17) May my neighbors receive Your Word that promises that if they believe the Gospel they become a child of God and a new creation. (Jn. 1:12; 2 Cor. 5:17) I pray that my neighbors’ identity is in the image and likeness of You, Father, Son, and Spirit. (Gen. 1:27; Eph. 2:10). May they walk and live as beloved, forgiven, and secure. Amen.

Wednesday: From Confusion & Chaos to Peace & Order – God, please help my neighbors in these confusing days and the storms of this world. (Matt. 8:26) Silence the chaos and bring Your perfect calm. Enable my neighbors to not focus on the “wind and the waves” of the newsfeed; but to keep their eyes on You alone and to have faith in You and not doubt. (Matt. 14:31) Provide, protect, help, heal, and clothe my neighbors according to Your faithfulness. (Phil. 4:19) Make my neighbors instruments of Your peace I humbly ask. Amen.

Thursday: From Princes & Principalities to Armor of Christ – Jesus, You say our battle is against rulers and powers. (Eph. 6:12) Forgive us for fighting a spiritual battle with carnal weapons—by our might and power instead of by Your Spirit. (Zech. 4:6) I pray my neighbors will fight the good fight of faith by putting on the full armor of Christ. Cloth them with truth, righteousness, the gospel of peace, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, and the sword of Your Spirit—the very Word of God. Do this in them so that when the day of evil comes, my neighbors may be able to stand in You and for You. (1 Tim. 6:12, Eph. 6:13). Amen.

Friday: From Deception to Truth – Father, thank You for shining your light in darkness and making Yourself known to us. (2 Cor. 4:6) I pray where the enemy has blinded the minds of my neighbors who are unbelievers and kept them from seeing the light of the Gospel (2 Cor. 4:4), open their eyes and shine Your light into the darkness of my neighbors’ hearts. Expose the lie that we can be saved from our own good works and help our neighbors to receive the truth of the Gospel. (Eph. 2:8-9) Jesus, set our neighbors free from the lie that there is another path to salvation other than You. (Jn. 14:6) For my neighbors who are believers, open their eyes to spiritual warfare and how the enemy is working in their lives. Teach my neighbors to fight for their families through prayer. (Eph. 6:10-18) Jesus invade my neighbor’s home with Your light so they may walk in truth. (Jn. 8:12; 3 Jn. 1:4) Amen.

Saturday: From Isolation to Connection – Father, thank You that nothing can separate your people from your love. (Rom. 8:37-39) Thank You for pouring Your love out for us through the Cross. (Jn. 3:16-17) Father, the greatest command You give is to love You and love others as we love ourselves. (Mk. 12:30-31) Awaken my neighbors’ hearts to their need for Your love and their need to love You and others. Heal my neighbors’ hearts and set them free from anything that is separating them from a relationship with You. Jesus, tear down the wall of isolation. (Jn. 10:10) Give our neighbors a desire to step out of isolation and into a community to connect with You, share their lives with others, and pray with others. (Acts 2:42-47) Father, for my neighbors who are saved but neglecting to gather in community with other believers, speak to their hearts and lead them to a church home to connect and serve with other believers. (Heb. 10:24-25) Amen.
