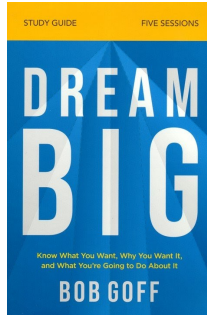

Dream Big – Grace Community

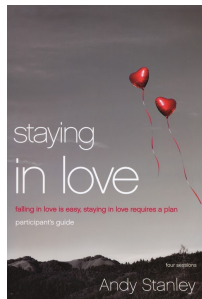

Staying in Love – Grace Community

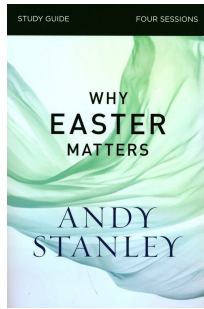

Why Easter Matters – Grace Community

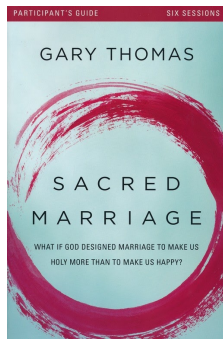

Sacred Marriage – L.I.F.E.

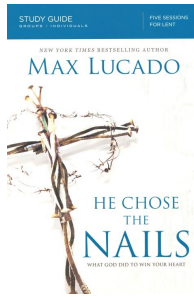

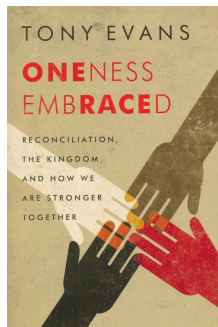

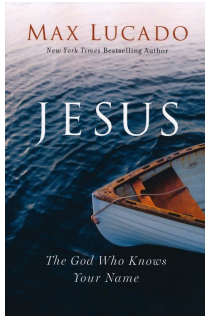

Jesus: The God Who Knows Your Name – Link



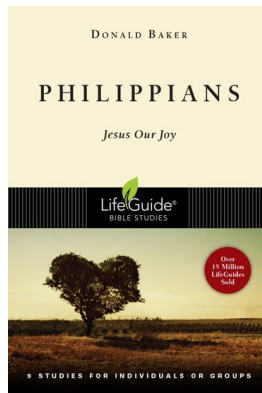

Race and the Gospel – Bereans



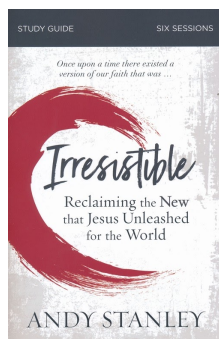

Philippians: Jesus Our Joy – Bereans



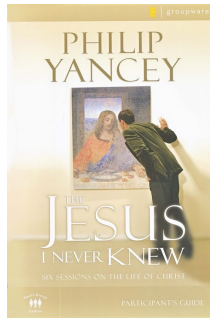

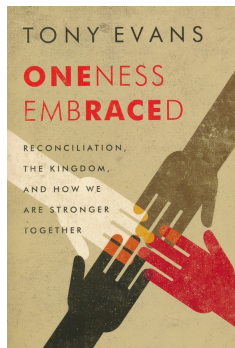
Weekly Topical Discussions – Disciples

Weekly Bible Study Discussion – Lyceum-Roundtable

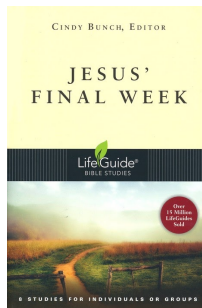
- What: Join Lyceum-Roundtable for a variety of topical and Biblically based discussions each week.
