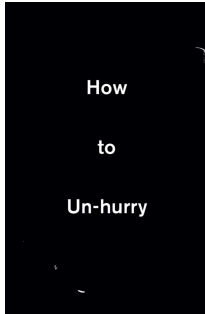

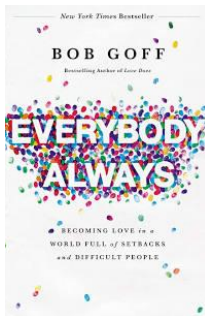

- When: Sundays, July 11 - August 8 ~ 9:30-10:30am

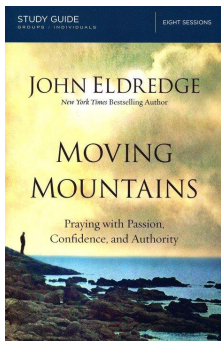

## ***Moving Mountains: Praying with Passion, Confidence and Authority*** – L.I.F.E.



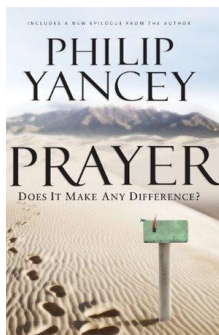

## ***Prayer: Does It Make Any Difference?*** – Link

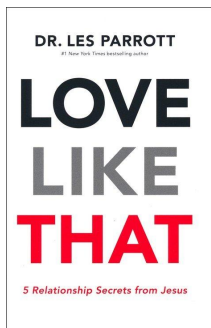

## ***Proverbs: Seven Virtues & Seven Deadly Sins*** – Bereans

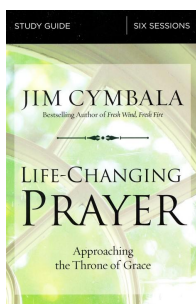

## ***Love Like That*** – Connect



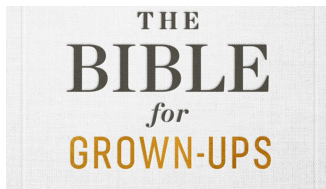

## ***Life-Changing Prayer*** – Connect



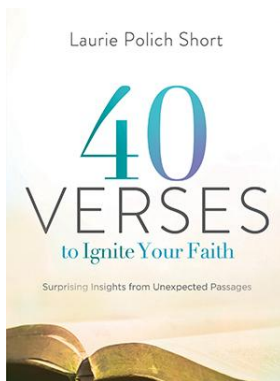

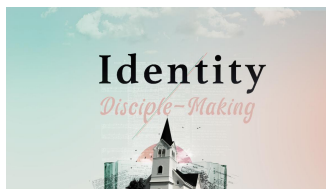
