## ***Come Alive: Galatians and Ephesians***

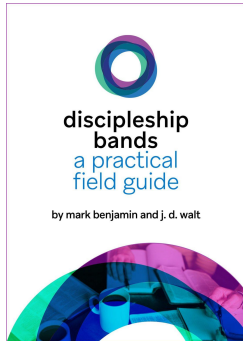
