## THE PASTOR'S MESSAGE

---

**My Renewed Thanks** – My personal great thanks to so many of you for your heartfelt messages and prayers and food during my recovery from the car accident that happened in early August. Certainly not what I expected for my annual time away, which was to be with family and friends, though Our Lord certainly had another plan. My recovery from surgery is going well and I was surprised to see so many of you among our parish family have had the same repair! My physician and those doing PT and OT with me tell me the process will several months to a year. That work though, definitely bolstered by your prayers – all such an important reminder for all of us of what it is to be part of our great Cathedral parish family!

**Celebrating the 100th Anniversary of the Dedication of Sacred Heart Church** – On-line sign-ups are now posted for time slots for our upcoming quarterly adoration of Our Lord, as part of our celebrations of the centenary of our beloved Sacred Heart Church. This quarterly 40 Hours with Our Lord is scheduled for **the week of Monday, September 9th through Friday, September 13**. As previous, during these days, we will be having at Sacred Heart Church, Eucharistic Adoration throughout the week during the daytime hours, plus additional Masses and eucharistic missionary journeys to the neighborhoods of our parishioners for prayer before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and other devotional activities, the details as follows:

- ◆ **Sacred Heart Centennial Mass** – September 9<sup>th</sup> is the actual 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the dedication of Sacred Heart. Join us for a celebration of this great anniversary with Mass at 6:30 pm in Sacred Heart, followed by a reception in the courtyard. Remember, seating is limited in Sacred Heart, though the outside speakers to the courtyard will serve the participation of those in the overflow outside.
- ◆ **40 Hours Masses** – Additional evening Masses during the week are planned at Sacred Heart: Tuesday at 6:30 pm (Spanish), Wednesday at 6:30 pm (Spanish), Thursday at 6:30 pm (Spanish) and Friday at 5:00 pm (English).
- ◆ **Cor ad cor loquitur** – let your heart speak to the Sacred Heart of Jesus through eucharistic adoration. Sign up on-line to spend some quiet time in Sacred Heart Church before Our Lord at <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/60B0F4CAEAB2EA2FE3-50688565-sep#/> and spend that hour with Him during the listed available times.
- ◆ **Missionaries of the Heart** – as you remember your own prayer intentions, also celebrate the best of our Catholic Eucharistic spirituality of adoration, which includes a missionary component: how we pray for the needs of our world, by a list of intentions provided.

**Our Eucharistic Missiology** – The Eucharist also bids us, having received Our Lord, to take Him to where we live and work and play and minister, thus, God engaging us in eucharistic missionary activity. For this quarterly celebration, we will be taking Our Lord to four different locations over two days during this week for prayer and blessing, as follows:

Two neighborhood visits, one to members of our Hispanic community directly following the 6:30 pm Mass on Tuesday, September 10th and one to members of our Anglo community directly following the 5:00 pm on Friday, September 11th.

Each visit will emphasize the importance of small communities of the faithful as places where the faith is nurtured. Additional prayers particular to each place will be said, followed by the celebration of Benediction before Our Lord is then brought back to Sacred Heart. Plan to join us!

**Catechetical Sunday** – Join me in prayer and gratitude to Our Lord for those among our Cathedral parish family who have discerned their gift of teaching and forming children, youth and adults and have stepped forward to deploy that gift in service to our parish. We will be praying over these serving as catechists at every Mass on Sunday, September 15, 2024.

**Save the Date: Parish Mission Celebrating our Sacred Heart Centenary** – Father John Harris, OP will be joining us the weekend of **September 21-22, 2024**, followed by Monday through Thursday, **September 23-26, 2024** for our parish mission. Father Harris is a good friend from our days in Rome and now serves as the Provincial for the Dominican Fathers in Ireland and is a highly regarded mission preacher, including several at Saint Patrick Cathedral in New York. I know you will join me in welcoming him here among our Cathedral parish family.

**Celebrating the Blue Mass Honoring our First Responders** – Each year on or about **September 29<sup>th</sup>**, the Feast of Saint Michael the Archangel, we join in honoring and blessing those who serve as First Responders. This year, that feast day falls on a Sunday and so **at the 10:30 am Mass** that day we will honor and bless those who serve as police officers, state troopers, EMS personnel and in our fire departments, in special gratitude for what they do to keep us safe. I know now anew and from first-hand experience from my recent car accident just how vital their role is within our community. Please join me that day as we give special thanks to them for all they do for us.




### LIVING FAITH COMMITTEE: WE NEED YOU!






