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### **Apprenticeship Training Tax Credit**

Employers that hire an Apprentice as a machine toolmaker, machinist, model-maker, gage maker, pattern-maker, plastic process technician, tool and machine setter, die-sinker, mold-maker, tool & die maker and similar occupations may be eligible for a tax credit of 50% of actual wages or \$4,800 whichever is less.
