Course Description: This course is designed to teach and encourage community members impacted by disaster to prepare, take preservation actions and perform, as appropriate, light search and rescue response to aid their family and other community members in the immediate aftermath of a natural disaster or human-made incident. **This course is NOT intended for the professional responder. This training does not qualify the participants to serve in an emergency responder role.**
