Robotics provides a fun way to keep students engaged in STEM education (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) while also improving skills in critical thinking and teamwork! Students will learn how to build simple robotic machines, use different types of sensors, and write computer programs to activate their robotic models.*

3:30-4:30, 5<sup>th</sup>–7<sup>th</sup> Grades will use the LEGO Mindstorms or EV3 kit



4:40-5:40, 4<sup>th</sup> Grade will use a beginner LEGO Robotics kit



Cost: \$330 for 10 classes, can be billed in two installments of \$165

*Cost includes use of computers and robot building kits.*

Class is held in the Elementary Library.

Instructor: Georgia Clark has a degree in electro-mechanical engineering and has taught Robotics for the past ten years to ages 8-17. She also coached the team “RoBUGs” that won multiple State Championships while competing in a worldwide robotics program called “FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition in Science and Technology)”. She continues to volunteer at many FIRST events and competitions.
