Susan currently serves as Associate Director for the Treasury Institute for Higher Education, an independent not for profit organization that promotes excellence in higher education treasury and financial management through development of educational programs and sharing of best practices. Susan was active with the Institute for several years as a practitioner and formerly served as a Board member.

Prior to her retirement in April 2020, Susan served as Treasurer for the University of Kentucky (UK) and was responsible for overseeing various financial and treasury functions including investments, endowments, debt, banking, payroll, accounts payable, travel management, student billing and collections, research accounting, cost accounting, property records, and accounting and preparation of internal and external financial reports. Susan joined UK in 1999 as the Manager of Treasury & Endowment Services and served in various positions at UK prior to her appointment as Treasurer in 2014.

Prior to joining the University of Kentucky, Susan served as a financial analyst for Lexmark International, Inc., an audit manager for Coopers & Lybrand (now PwC), and an internal auditor for Kentucky Utilities, Inc. During her tenure at Coopers & Lybrand, Susan performed financial statement audits for clients in the banking and higher education industries.

Susan remains engaged in the higher education industry through her work with the Treasury Institute and by serving as a faculty member for the College Business Management Institute and a mentor for the University of Kentucky Gatton College of Business & Economics Women Business Leaders program. Susan is also active in her community, serving on the Bluegrass Community Foundation Investment Committee and the Bank of the Bluegrass Advisory Board.
