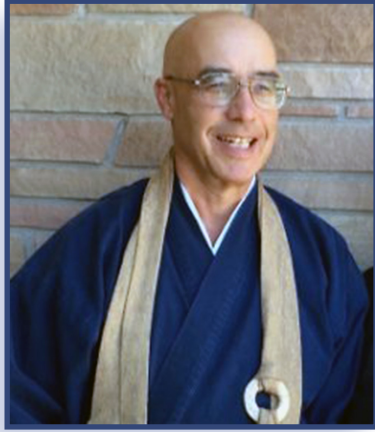


How do we face the great violence, arrogance and selfishness in this world from a Buddhist perspective?
