# Competency Domains

The content areas, otherwise known as domains, describe knowledge and skills that early childhood educators need in order to work effectively with children birth through age eight and their families. In order to increase knowledge and skills, early childhood educators are expected to participate in quality continuing education opportunities (e.g., college classes, community-based, state approved training, etc.). Embedded throughout the domains, when appropriate, are competencies specific to cultural competence as well as the inclusion of all children.

## **The domains included within Colorado's Competencies for Early Childhood Educators and Administrators are:**

- ◆ Child Growth, Development, and Learning (CGDL)
- ◆ Health, Safety, and Nutrition (HSN)
- ◆ Child Observation and Assessment (COA)
- ◆ Professional Development and Leadership (PDL)
- ◆ Family and Community Partnerships (FCP)
- ◆ Program Planning and Development (PPD)
- ◆ Guidance (G)
- ◆ Teaching Practice (TP)

# What is a CEU?

CEU stands for Continuing Education Unit. The primary purpose of the CEU is to provide a permanent record of the educational accomplishments of an individual who has completed one or more significant *non-credit* educational experience.

In a continuing education program, one CEU is equivalent to 10 contact hours. Contact hours are the number of hours you are "in contact" with an instructor.

When pursuing CEUs to earn points towards your Early Childhood Credential in the Colorado Shines Professional Development Information System (PDIS), the CEU must:

- Have the International Association for Continuing Education (IACET) logo OR be from a regionally accredited college/university; and
- Coursework of the CEU must also be directly related to the field of early childhood.

To determine whether or not a course is "Early Childhood Coursework" for the purpose of the Early Childhood Professional Credential, PDIS looks for courses that:

- Align with the Colorado Competencies for Early Childhood Educators and Administrators;
- Include content that is focused on ages birth to eight years old (at a minimum, more than 50% of that age span), or
- Address Cultural Competence, Children with High Needs, Social Emotional Development, or a basic understanding of research as these topics are embedded within the Early Childhood. Competencies.

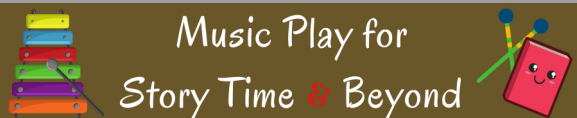

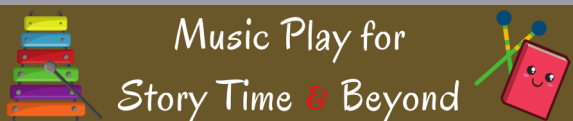
