

How many hours of Universal Preschool do I qualify for?

A guide for families.

15 hours

Every child in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten.

30 hours

Children in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten AND with one or more qualifying factors, pending availability and funding.

Qualifying Factors:

- Household Income
- Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- Housing Status
- Dual Language Learner
- Foster/Kinship Care

10 hours

Three-year olds with one or more qualifying factors.
