What is Race for Education?

It's an annual fundraiser to raise money for our school where students are actively involved without selling items door to door. This is the 14th year our school has conducted Race for Education!

When is Race for Education this year?

Race for Education will be held on Friday, April 20, 2018.

How does Race for Education work?

School families provide names and addresses of potential sponsors. Students write a note at school asking sponsors to contribute a gift to SPSL. *These names will not be used for any other purpose.* Pre-K through 8th grade students walk/run for 50 minutes on school grounds the day of the Race. They also get to enjoy a snow cone as a treat!

How is the money raised from Race for Education used?

Donations go toward the educational needs of our school such as Accelerated Reading Programs, textbooks, Star Math testing materials and technology based instruction enhancements like BrainPop.

How much money is raised?

Last year, we raised almost \$47,000 after expenses. We hope to exceed that goal this year.

What can parents do to help?
