

This year schools are not assigned a designated week and buses will not be picking up at school locations. All bus pick up and drop off sites are now located at City of Omaha Recreation Sites.

In the past, the week that was designated for St. Pius X/St. Leo School is the third week in July, which would be July 16 -20, 2018. Per request of some of our school parents we are suggesting to our families who wish to sign their child up for camp with other SPSL students to register for this week. However, you can sign up for any week you want to, there are no restrictions on who signs up for which week.

Registration for Hummel Camp is from March 5-15, with each day designated as the first day of registering for a specific week of camp. Such as, March 5 opens registration for the week of June 4, March 6 opens registration for the week of June 11, etc. So, to register for the week of **July 16 – 20 registration will open on March 12 at 8:00 AM.** If you wish to register for this week we suggest you do it promptly at 8:00 am as it fills up quickly, last year it was full by 8:05 AM. The closest bus pick up location to St. Pius X and St. Leo for the week of July 16 is at Camelot Community Center at 9270 Cady Ave (just north of 92 & Blondo St). • If this date doesn't work for or you get waitlisted, you can always choose another week that has openings from another date and pickup site. Just check the website.

Here's some more information about registering:

- Camp is for kids that are currently in 1st-7th grades, there are no age exceptions. Camp runs Monday-Thursday from 9:00am-4:00pm and Friday 1:00pm-6:30pm. Bus times will be BEFORE and AFTER these times. There is no return bus on Friday nights.
- No schools are assigned a certain week or number of spots. Kids may only attend ONE week of camp.
- Registration begins online at 8:00am on your week's registration start date. Patrons may also register in person at any Community Center at 8:00am, or when the Center opens (Please check our website for Community Center hours) where cash, checks and credit cards are accepted. Your week of camp will continue to stay open for registration until the week is completely filled and then a waitlist will be started.
- In order to register for camp, patrons will need to log in to their account or create an account if they don't have one. In February we will email all past participants with their usernames.
- BEFORE the registration start date, they will want to log in to their account and make sure all their household information is up to date, including names, addresses, phone numbers, birthdates, grades, and email addresses. If there are any questions with an account, please call the Florence Community Center at [402-444-5216](tel:402-444-5216).
- The Camp fee is \$95. For any child that receives Free or Reduced Lunch through the schools, the Camp fee is lowered to \$35. Patrons need to call the Florence Community Center, preferably now, to get a "Reduced Fee Pass" put on to their household and also find out how to submit documentation. Then they will be able to register like normal the day of registration.
- Immediately upon registering online, patrons should receive a payment receipt emailed to them. Informational letters about Camp will be emailed out to participants closer to summer.
